The Opportunity

The incumbent will manage the external security provider contract, lead the Security/SafeUSC team in the provision of high-quality community services, and undertake risk management to ensure alignment with AMS business requirements, University strategic plans, as well as compliance with relevant policies and legislation. The Senior Manager, Security/SafeUSC will contribute to the broader management of the work area including the provision of expert advice to the Director, AMS, senior staff and University committees; strategic and operational planning; change management initiatives; and contribution to the achievement of significant University objectives.

This is a role which will requires a sound understanding of contemporary security and emergency management frameworks including business continuity management and critical incident management. The incumbent will hold postgraduate qualifications with extensive relevant experience in a university or similar complex organisational environment. In addition, the incumbent will have experience in the provision of security/community support services, emergency management,

security, and operational risk management. Leadership experience and skills in staff and resource management are essential, as is the proven ability to deliver a culture of responsive and innovative customer-oriented solutions.
